If you do not have access yet, please contact the International Office staff.

Your matriculation number

Your matriculation number can be found when you log on to https://idservice.mau.se/. This matriculation number is used to identify you as a student at Malmö University. Memorize it or write it down and carry it with you—you may need to use it more than you think! The format will be your date of birth followed by T and three numbers: YYYYMMDD-TXXX.

Computer identity (Computer-ID)

Please follow the instructions on: https://idservice.mau.se/ to retrieve a computer identity. Your computer identity is used for a number of things, like accessing the wireless network, using campus computers and logging in to Canvas courses.

Multicard

Your multicard is the ID card that can be used to access university buildings, check out books from the library, and copy and print with the university's printers. As soon as you have a computer identity you will be able to order your multicard by logging in to https://idservice.mau.se/ with your computer identity, selecting 'multicard' and following the instructions.

WIFI

You need your computer identity to access the wireless network Eduroam. Read more about WiFi and how to log in at: https://student.mau.se/en/student-services/it-support/wireless-network/
