

## **INVITATION TO TAKE PART IN A PILOT WORKSHOP ON ENERGY SCENARIOS AND JUSTICE**

The research project “Energy scenarios and justice – a case study of Sweden” at Malmö University examines how concerns for national, global and intergenerational justice can be integrated into the construction and assessment of energy scenarios. As part of the project, workshops with civil servants and representatives of NGOs will be held in Malmö and Stockholm in November this year. In preparation for these workshops, we will arrange a pilot workshop at the end of September/beginning of October this year and we invite students from Lund and Malmö University to take part in that. We will send out a doodle to set the time of the workshop when we have enough participants. The purpose of the pilot workshop is to test the methods that will be used in the later workshops and the results will not be used in the project.

In the workshop, the participants will evaluate long-term energy scenarios for Sweden from a justice perspective. Besides contributing to the development of the method for the project, the participants will have the opportunity to learn more about the relevance of justice for the construction and evaluation of energy scenarios. The workshop will take between 3-4 hours and will be in the form of a Zoom meeting. The meeting will not be recorded.
